Minutes**

**January 25, 2014 Saturday Workshop**

This was the Saturday Workshop meeting (originally scheduled for Sat. Jan. 18, 2014) to review all the articles and budget items.

A quorum was present: 5 members were present, 5 were missing, all selectmen were present.

Just before lunch, Emil voted to accept, Doug seconded, and all voted to approve the December 2013 minutes.

We listened to the agency requests for funds.

Then it was time to hear from Fire/EMS. Mike Hartford spoke about the Rescue 2 repair and the funds needed for that department.

Howard Allen then spoke on Camp Moy Mo Da Yo and their 2014 funding requests, speaking about the engineering and work permits that were spent out of the \$19,000 that they had wanted last year. They turned the rest back to the Town.

He talked about the anti-erosion aspects of the engineering and that they would be requesting that money again for the boat ramp.

We talked about the Eco Maine--that the tonnage costs were dropping and the assessment would be \$0.00 beginning July 1.

We talked about the public hearing that was going to be held Feb. 6 and then we discussed the articles that would show up in the Town report warrant for the Saturday (Town) Meeting (March 1, 2014).

After that we entertained a motion to adjourn.
