Draft Marijuana Ordinance

Joyce Foley opened the meeting by saying the meeting tonight was called to begin discussions concerning the drafting of a marijuana ordinance for the town.

Stanley Hackett supplied the Board with a copy of the marijuana ordinance from the Town of Lyons, Colorado and Redmond, Washington and the Planning Board will work with these 2 ordinances and the Chapter 417, Marijuana Legalization Act, as drafted by the Maine Legislature.

Joyce Foley said she had spoken with the Maine Municipal Association today and they indicated there were possible amendments being added to the Chapter 417, Marijuana Legalization Act and the attorney at Maine Municipal Association felt it would be a waste of time to have any discussion until the Maine Legislature held their discussions and/or amendments were added.

Joyce further said that there was a possibility that the Selectmen of Limington may ask for a 180 day moratorium that would give the Planning Board additional time to draft an ordinance.

Joyce Foley suggested that the members review the material presented tonight from Stanley.

Minutes of September 20, 2016

Joyce asked that item No. 4 under Conditions of Approval state “no permanent mobile homes” instead of no mobile homes. Joyce made a motion to approve the minutes and Tom seconded. All in favor and motion carried.

Joyce the members to begin reviewing the material concerning marijuana ordinance material provided by Stanly Hackett and we will meet again on February 7, 2017.
