SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES November 26, 2014

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Raymond Cullen and Darryl Hubbard; Residents and Guest – Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Cullen called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Meeting Minutes:** Selectman Hubbard made a motion to approve the November 20, 2014 Selectmen Meeting Minutes, second by Selectman Cullen and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant #48:** Selectman Hubbard made a motion to approve Warrant #48: Appropriations: \$272,545.85 and Payroll \$16,444.64 for a total of \$288,990.49 second by Selectman Cullen and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Cullen made a motion to approve a purchase order request to pay Buxton Napa \$107.51 for anti-rust protection spray for plow trucks, so moved by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.
- **Brush Removal:** Selectman Cullen made a motion to approve a purchase order request to pay Wescott & Sons \$159.10 for pole saw drive shaft, so moved by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.
- **Fire Department:** Selectman Cullen made a motion to approve purchase order requests to pay Cornish Hardware \$162.63 for batteries for air packs; a request to have the annual flow test done on air packs by Northeastern Fire Apparatus; a request to pay K & L Custom Upholstery \$50.00 for repairs done to a hose bed cover, so moved by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Compactor Update:** Selectman Hubbard reported the compactor will be up and running and everything goes up to the Transfer Station. Hours are 9-4 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. The containers (silver bullets) will no longer be outback the Municipal Complex.
- **Holiday Trash Pick Up:** Selectman Hubbard reported trash pickup will on Friday this week due to Thanksgiving being on Thursday. Please have trash out early.
- **Town Offices** will be closing at 1:30 p.m. today due to the weather.
- **Committee Openings:** The Town has openings on the following committees: Old Town Hall Preservation Committee, the Moy-Mo-Da-Yo Recreational Area Oversight Committee, and a member plus an alternate to the Saco River Corridor Commission. - **General Assistance Office:** GA office is open Tuesday from 3:00 p.m. to 5 p.m. Applications are available at the front office during business hours.
- **Transfer Station Hours:** Saturday and Sunday's from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- **Compactor:** All recyclable materials will now be deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station on Pine Hill Road. The silver recycling containers will no longer be behind the Municipal Complex. Transfer Station dump stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclable materials and television/computer type products. See this weeks' ad in "Your Weekly Shopping Guide."
- **Planet Aid yellow container** for cloths and shoes **only** has been relocated to the Transfer Station.
- **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Tuesday evenings, 7:00 p.m.

- **Limington Christmas Toy Box:** The Limington Christmas Toy Box is now accepting applications from Limington families who need assistance to purchase gifts for their children. If you are interesting in helping Limington families in need at Christmas, gift ideas are available on cards at the Town Office. Just pick one or more up, purchase the gift specified on the card, and return it unwrapped to the box in the hall. We are also accepting monetary donations.
