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## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

December 18, 2014

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Raymond Cullen, Bruce Rozett and Darryl Hubbard; Residents and Guest –Bonnie Lord, Ron Phinney, Emil Braley, James Bradbury, Stanley Blake, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Cullen called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Meeting Minutes:** Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to approve the December 11, 2014 Selectmen Meeting Minutes, so moved by Selectman Rozett, seconded by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant #51:** Selectman Rozett made a motion to approve Warrant #51: Appropriations: \$34,065.73 and Payroll \$9,097.52 for a total of \$43,163.25 second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

### Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to approve purchase order requests to pay Napa-Buxton \$35.16 for truck# 8 and 11-wiper blades, and \$27.98 for truck#14 lights and Shaw Bros. \$3,408.00 for 480 yards of screened sand, so moved by Selectman Rozett, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.
- **Municipal Complex:** Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to approve a purchase order request to pay Doug Hubbard, Electrician \$174.00 to repair ceiling lights in office, so moved by Selectman Rozett, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

## **Old and New Business:**

• **Sale of Town Plow Truck:** Selectman Rozett made a motion to award the sale of the 1987 GMC Brigadere plow truck, plow wing, and dump body to Michael Hanson for \$3,100, second by Selectman Hubbard, and vote unanimous.

• **Old Town Hall:** Selectman Rozett made a motion to award the Old Town Hall fire escape construction bid to Sheridan Corporation from Fairfield, ME for \$27,237, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous. The cost of the fire escape will be paid by the auto insurance of the gentleman that hit and damaged it.

• **“Winter Maintenance Road Closing”:** A public hearing was held at 7:00 p.m. before the Selectmen’s Meeting regarding the road closing and there was no questions or comments. Selectman Rozett made a motion to close for winter maintenance Beaver Berry Road and a portion of River Rd and Tucker Rd, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

• **Special Town Meeting:** Selectman Rozett reported there will be a Special Town Meeting, Thursday, January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. and made a motion to approve the Warrant as written, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous:

**Article 1** - To choose a moderator to preside over the meeting.

**Article 2** - To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to expend a total sum of \$197,766 for EMS Medical Billing (Account 2800) for the 2014 fiscal year and to transfer an additional \$20,000 from the 2014 EMS Medical Billing income to cover the additional expense.

(2014 budget was \$177,766 with \$100,000 taken from billing income to offset expense)  
(Selectmen in favor 3-0) (Not yet reviewed with Financial Advisory Board)

**Article 3** - To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to expend a total of \$10,696 for Animal Control (Account 2600) for the 2014 fiscal year and to transfer \$610 from the Firefighter Stipends Account (Account 2509) to cover the additional expense. (2014 article was \$10,086)

(Selectmen in favor 3-0) (Not yet reviewed with Financial Advisory Board)

**Article 4** – Adjourn.
