- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Raymond Cullen, Darryl Hubbard and Bruce Rozett; Residents and Guest –Bonnie Lord, Jason Smith, Emil Braley, Ron Phinney and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Cullen called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.**
- **Approval of Warrant #4:** Selectman Rozett made a motion to approve Warrant #4: Appropriations: \$257,887.32 and Payroll \$8,517.86 for a total of \$266,405.18 second by Selectman Cullen and vote unanimous.

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to approve the following purchase order request; a request to pay Morton Salt \$3,449.04 for 63.32 tons of salt; a request to pay Sleepers Supermarket \$250.89 for plow truck diesel fuel; a request to pay Portland North \$13.90 for starter relay on truck #10; a request to pay Napa Auto Parts \$75.95 for exhaust reducer and clamps on truck #6; a request to pay Chartier and Co \$75.00 to adjust clutch on truck #11; a request to pay Freightliner of Maine \$681.30 for clutch kit, pilot bearing, and rear main seal for truck #11 and \$133.55 for transmission casting for truck #13; a request to pay Portland North \$81.05 for air valve, blind spot mirrors, bolts and washers for truck #14; and a request to pay Portland North \$686.21 for compressor assembly and governor assembly for truck #10; Selectman Rozett so moved and second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

- **EMS Dept.:** Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to approve a request to pay Bound Tree Medical \$1,319.13 for January medical supplies, so moved by Bruce Rozett, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.
- **Fire Dept.:** a request to pay Cornish Hardware \$22.98 for flashlight batteries and a request to pay Moulton Lumber \$40.29 for station hand-railing so moved by Bruce Rozett, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

**Old and New Business:**

- **2015 Town Meeting Warrant Articles:** Selectman Rozett made a motion to attest the Warrant for Town Meeting to be held Friday, March 6 and Saturday, March 7, 2015, second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.
- **Informational Public Hearing:** Selectman Rozett reported Selectmen will hold an Informational Public Hearing on Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. on Town Meeting Secret Ballot warrant articles 3 and 4 so voters can come and gather whatever information they need to vote on these two articles.
- **Committee Openings:** The Town has openings on the following committees: Financial Advisory Committee, Old Town Hall Preservation Committee, the Moy-Mo-Da-Yo Recreational Area Oversight Committee, and a member plus an alternate to the Saco River Corridor Commission.
