SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

January 29, 2015

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Raymond Cullen, Darryl Hubbard and Bruce Rozett; Residents and Guest –Willard Boothby, Rep. Johnathan Kinney, Ron Phinney and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Cullen called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.**
- **Approval of Warrant #5:** Selectman Rozett made a motion to approve Warrant #5: Appropriations: \$15,772.33 and Payroll \$8,548.46 for a total of \$24,320.79 second by Selectman Hubbard and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Office Supplies:** Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to approve a purchase order request to pay Maine Info Network, LLC \$170 for two credit card readers, so moved by Selectman Rozett, second by Selectman Hubbard, and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Lawn Maintenance Bids:** Selectman Hubbard reported the Selectmen bid out the Municipal Building and Salt Shed lawn area maintenance and received two bids which are Sterling Insect/Lawn Control, Inc. for \$2,133.92 and TRUGREEN Commercial for \$1,182. These bids include weed/crabgrass and grub control, fertilizer, and lime application. Selectman Hubbard made a motion to award the bid to TRUEGREEN Commercial for \$1,182, second by Selectman Rozett and vote unanimous.
- **Informational Public Hearing** to be held Thursday, February 19th at 7:00 p.m. here in the meeting room to answer questions in regards to Town Meeting Secret Ballot Warrant Articles 3 and 4.

• **Committee Openings:** The Town has openings on the following committees: Old Town Hall Preservation Committee, the Moy-Mo-Da-Yo Recreational Area Oversight Committee, and a member plus an alternate to the Saco River Corridor Commission. Informational Bulletin:

• **General Assistance Office:** GA office is open Tuesday from 3:00 p.m. to 5 p.m. Applications are available at the front office during business hours.

• **Transfer Station Hours:** Saturday and Sunday’s from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday’s 12-4 p.m.

• **Recycling:** All recyclable materials are to be deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station on Pine Hill Road. Transfer Station dump stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclable materials and television/computer type products. There is a dumpster for household trash if you missed the curbside pickup. Selectman Rozett reported the Town has dumped the compactor twice with around 13 tons total (Silver bullets would have been hauled 4-5 times with this tonnage).

• **Planet Aid yellow container** for cloths and shoes only is at the Transfer Station.

• **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Tuesday evenings, 7:00 p.m.

• **Dog Licenses:** Selectman Rozett mentioned dog licenses must be renewed by Saturday, after that there is a \$25.00 late registration fee.

• **Website:** Selectman Rozett mentioned there is a copy of the secret ballot and Warrant for March 6th and 7th Annual Town Meeting on the Town website.

• **Pushing Snow Across roadways** by State law is illegal and Selectman Rozett mentioned if you do so, you may be visited by the Town Deputy. (Please do not park your car on the streets during snow storms.)

• **Meeting Open to Public:**

Rep. Johnathan Kinney reported the Limington-Steep Falls Bridge on route 11 is open for Public Hearing on 3, February at 2:00 p.m. in the Transportation Committee room at the State House to name that bridge the “Veterans Memorial Bridge.” If anyone has comments or testimony they would like him to deliver to the Hearing please contact him this weekend, he would add it to his testimony.

The Bureau of Alcohol and Lottery in the State of Maine is moving forward with Keno machines and will be installing them in around 135 sites within the State.

Rep. Kinney will be visiting with ecoMaine next Friday morning to see what they have to say and listen to any complaints they may have.

The State of State Address by the Governor is this Tuesday night at 7:00 p.m.

The State of Maine is still giving out tax credits or rebates of \$500 on heat pumps that have been installed.

Adjourn: Selectman Cullen asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:19 p.m., so moved by Selectman Rozett, vote unanimous.
