SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

December 1, 2016

POSTED

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo
- Residents and Guest – Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Rozett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of November 22, 2016 as written, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 48** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve Warrant #48:
Appropriations: \$18,150.15 and Payroll \$16,245.09 for a total of \$34395.24, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Purchase Orders

- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the following purchase order requests: the purchase two new rescue lap tops from Telrepcos for \$3,390.00; to purchase two each of new EMS member name tapes, American flag patches, removal of EMT patch and replace with flags from Allen's Uniform; to purchase one case of highway flares from Heiman for \$107.9; and to purchase parts for Rescue 1 from Sanel Auto for \$59.00, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the following purchase order requests: to pay Morton Salt \$6,077.59 for 95.68 ton of road salt and a request to have Rowe Ford do engine repair on F550 for \$3,400.00, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Special Town Meeting:** Selectman Amatrudo read warrant articles for the December 8th Special Town Meeting which will be called to order at 7:30 p.m. in this room after the Selectmen's Meeting.
Article 1 - To choose a moderator to preside over the meeting.
Article 2 - To see if the Town will vote to appropriate an additional amount, not to exceed \$15,000.00 for Curbside Tonnage (Account # 3600-8010). Said funds to be transferred from the General Fund.
Article 3 - To see if the Town will vote to appropriate an additional amount, not to exceed \$2,597.97 for County Taxes (Acct # 7100-0800). Said funds to be transferred from the General Fund.
Article 4 – To see if the Town will authorize the municipal officers to pay for emergency Old Town Hall water damage cleanup, not to exceed \$7,859.40. Said funds to come from the property tax overlay funds (Acct # 7200-0801).
Article 5 – Adjourn

Transfer Station Hours: Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. The Station will close early at 3 p.m. on Saturday's December 24th & 31st and closed Sunday's December 25th & January 1st for the holidays.

- **Recycling:** Recyclable materials are deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station. Stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclables, televisions or computer type products. A sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. A dumpster is available if you missed the curbside household trash pickup.
