SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES December 15, 2016

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Bruce Rozett, Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo
- Residents and Guest – Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Rozett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**

• **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of December 8, 2016 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

• **Approval of Warrant # 50** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve Warrant #50: Appropriations: \$249,586.80 and Payroll \$8,107.36 for a total of \$257,694.16, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Purchase Orders

- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Braley read the request to have TelrepcO recondition two rescue computers for future use on fire vehicles for \$880.00, so moved by Selectmen Rozett, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **Code Enforcement:** Selectman Braley read the request to purchase Town of Limington Building Permit and Shoreland Permit Cards from Cardinal Printing Co. Inc. for \$78.26, so moved by Selectmen Rozett, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Braley read the purchase order requests to pay Morton Salt \$6,338.03 for 99.78 tons of road salt; request to reimburse Heath Edgerly \$315.44 EGR valve for truck #8; and a request to pay Maine Local Roads \$75.00 for three people to attend the Snow & Ice Control workshop, so moved by Selectmen Rozett, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business

- **Executive Session:** Selectmen Rozett reported the Selectmen will hold an executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. § 405(6)(F) for the discussion of confidential records for a poverty abatement on Wednesday, December 21st at 4:30 p.m.
- **Cold Weather Warning:** Selectman Rozett asked residents to please check on their elderly neighbors during this cold weather coming in for Friday along with snow on Saturday.
- **2017 Dog Registrations are due by December 31, 2016.** The fee is \$6.00 for neutered dogs and \$11.00 for non-neutered dogs. A late fee of \$25.00 will be imposed after January 31.
- **Nomination Papers** for the following offices are available and must be returned by January 17, 2017:
 - Selectman/Assessor/Overseer of the Poor – 1 position (three year term)
 - Planning Board Member – 1 position (three year terms)
 - Davis Memorial Library Trustee – 2 positions (one 5 year term & one 1 year term)
 - M.S.A.D.#6 School Board Members – 2 positions (one 2 year term & one 3 year term)

- **Town Offices Holiday Schedule:** Town Office will be closed Friday- December 23, Friday- December 30 at 12 noon and all day Monday- January 2.
- **Transfer Station Hours:** Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. The Station will close early at 3 p.m. on Saturday's December 24th & 31st and closed Sunday's December 25th & January 1st. New Transfer Station stickers are available at the Town Office for \$15.00.
- **Recycling:** Recyclable materials are deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station. Stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclables, televisions or computer type products.
