SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES January 12, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Bruce Rozett, Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo
- Residents and Guest – Howard Allen and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Rozett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of January 5, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 2:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve warrant #2; Appropriations: \$57,749.91 - Payroll: \$8,954.25 for a total of 66,704.16, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

Selectman Braley read the following purchase request:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve a request to purchase wipers, manifold, and hardware from Portland North for \$875.00 for truck #14; a request to purchase a set of 20' heavy duty jumper cables from Sanel Auto for \$350; a request to pay Morton Salt \$6,240.84 for 98.25 tons of road salt and a request to purchase wiper transmission for truck# 6 from O'Connor's, estimated cost \$150, second by Selectman Rozett and vote unanimous.
- **Town Clerks Office:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve a request to pay Maine Town & City Clerks Assn. \$50.00 for two MTCCA dues, second by Selectman Rozett and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Nomination Papers** for the following offices are available and must be returned by January 17, 2017:
 - Selectman/Assessor/Overseer of the Poor – 1 position (three year term)
 - Planning Board Member – 1 position (three year terms)
 - Davis Memorial Library Trustee – 2 positions (one 5 year term & one 1 year term)
 - M.S.A.D. #6 School Board Members – 2 positions (one 2 year term & one 3 year term)
- **Town Offices Closed** Monday, January 16th in honor of Martin Luther King.
- **Annual Horne Pond Fishing Derby**, Saturday, January 28th from 5 a.m. to 3 p.m. Selectman Braley mentioned Brittany Humphrey of Hooked on Fishing will hold a "Learn to Ice Fish" class from 9 a.m. to noon and kids of all ages are welcome. FMI: call Peter @ 207-572-5685.
- **Attest referendum questions:** Selectman Rozett reported there are two ballot questions for Friday, March 3, 2017 Annual Town Meeting:

"To see if the Town will vote to enact a "Moratorium Ordinance Regarding Recreational Marijuana Retail Establishments and Social Clubs," which will impose a moratorium on the licensing, permitting, construction and/or operation of recreational marijuana establishments and/or social clubs in the Town of Limington for a period of 180 days so that the Town may enact necessary zoning, land use, and/or licensing ordinances to regulate such uses."

"To see if the town will vote to direct the Municipal Officers to enter into a contract with the York County Sheriff for the purpose of deployment of a deputy that is dedicated to the town for 40 hours per week for the period of May 2, 2017 through June 30, 2018 and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$106,191.13 to fund this contract."

Selectman Rozett made a motion to attest these two questions for the secret ballot vote on Friday, March 3, 2017, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

• **Trash:** Selectman Amatrudo mentioned the weather has severely hampered curbside pickup. Due to the warm weather the roads have become compacted with ice and are very slippery and in many cases it has become too dangerous for the trash truck to go down these roads. If you live on a private road and your trash hasn't been picked up, that simply means CIA has determined that the road is too slippery to take a truck down and risk getting it stuck or hurting one of their people. Whoever cleans your road, you want to make a good faith effort to get the road cleared. If your trash was not picked up, you may either take it to the Transfer Station on Saturday or Sunday, or you can wait until your next regular pickup. Selectman Rozett mentioned the State law and a decision by the State Supreme Court has made it very clear, that absolutely no taxpayer money is spent on maintaining, plowing or sanding private roads.

• **Committee Openings:** The Town has openings on the following committees: Old Town Hall Preservation Committee, Planning Board, Emergency Management Director, one Saco River Corridor Commission Alternate, and residents to service on the 225th Celebration Committee. A sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. A dumpster is available if you missed the curbside household trash pickup.

• **General Assistance Office:** GA office is open Tuesday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Applications are available at the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be completed with supporting documentation and signed.

• **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Tuesday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex.

• **Financial Advisory Committee's** will hold their Annual Budget Meeting on Saturday January 21, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. Everyone is welcome to attend.
