February 2, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Bruce Rozett, Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo
- Residents and Guest – Debra Black and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Rozett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of January 26, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 5:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve **warrant #5;**
Appropriations: \$39,453.15 - Payroll: \$8,559.75 for a total of \$48,012.90, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
