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## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

February 23, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Bruce Rozett, Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo  
- Residents and Guest –Charlie Huntress, Jonathan Kinney, Eugene Rusch, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Rozett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of February 16, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 8:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve Warrant #8:  
Appropriations: \$32,970.40 - Payroll: \$14,064.39 for a total of \$47,034.79, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

### Purchase Order Requests:

#### • **Fire/EMS:**

Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests: a request to reimburse Chief Hartford \$179.34 for purchase of replacement shelving in Engine 3 cabinet; a request to reimburse Earl Maxwell \$93.55 for Hazmat class luncheon; a request to reimburse Chief Hartford \$101.97 to have laser jet printer refurbished; a request to pay Threads, Rags & Duds \$31.65 for the repair of gear pants; and a request to pay Sleepers Hardware \$42.18 for two shovels, so moved by Selectman Rozett, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

• **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests: a request to pay Phillips Body Shop \$600.00 to recover plow truck from ditch; a request to purchase an ignition switch from Freightliner for truck 11, estimated cost \$10.00; a request to pay Sanel Auto estimated cost of \$250.00 for hydraulic hose, fittings and hardware purchased for truck 13; and a request to pay Morton Salt \$6,070.61 for 95.57 tons of road salt, so moved by Selectman Rozett, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

• **Saco River TV:** Selectman Rozett so moved a request to reimburse Fausto Blasco \$26.25 for plugs, clamps, and wire for videotaping, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

### Old and New Business:

• **Ambulance Subscription Form and Survey:** The Ambulance Subscription Form will arrive in your mailbox soon. Selectman Amatrudo highly recommends you fill it out and get the ambulance subscription plan. With the ambulance subscription form there is a resident survey which is a survey on the services the town provides. Please fill it out, we are asking for just one per household, and return the survey along with the ambulance subscription form by mail or drop it off at the town office.

• **Town Meeting:** Friday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> polls open at 8:00 a.m. for Municipal election and referendum vote and close at 8:00 p.m. Polls will reopen at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, March 4<sup>th</sup> for open Town Meeting.

• **MSAD 6 Apportionment Committee Meeting:** Selectman Braley reported he attended the last meeting and this apportionment is a balance of power between the towns on the school board. The next meeting will be March 2, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. and is open to the public.

- **Transfer Station Hours:** Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials are deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station. Stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclables, televisions or computer type products. A sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. A dumpster is available if you missed the curbside household trash pickup.
