SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

March 9, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo and Debra Black
- Residents and Guest –Jason Smith and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Rozett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen’s Meeting minutes of March 2, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 10:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #10 as published: Appropriations: \$27,834.75 - Payroll: \$8,037.00 for a total of \$35,871.75, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Highway Dept.:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve a request to pay Napa Auto \$141.00 for parts on Truck #6 and 15, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the requests to pay Matheson Tri-Gas \$209.66 for argon and acetylene; to pay Shaw Earthworks \$2,116.80 for 252 cy of road sand; to purchase a transmission bell housing for truck 6 from White Bradstreet, estimated cost \$525; to pay O’Connor \$2,125.00 for parts for truck 6; and to pay Matheson Tri-Gas \$443.33 for oxygen, acetylene, and argon, so moved by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Sanford Veteran Center:** Selectman Amatrudo reported Mr. Matthew Haley from the Sanford Veteran’s Center will be at the Old Town Hall April 21st and May 19th from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. He is going to be there for anybody who wants to stop in and pamphlets will be out with more information when we get them.
- **Ambulance Subscription Form and Survey:** Selectman Amatrudo mentioned the ambulance subscription plan should be in your mail along with a town survey. The ambulance subscription is the cheapest insurance you can buy and the survey will help the Selectmen chart out the needs of the town.
- **Letter from Town of Hollis Selectboard:** Selectman Braley read a letter from Hollis Selectboard praising the Limington Fire Department for their exceptional timely and professional manner resulting in saving a residence from being consumed by fire and the rescue of a family pet. There were no injuries. The Town of Hollis greatly appreciated the efforts of your firefighters and officers and commends them for their professional call to duty.
