SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

March 23, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo and Debra Black
- Residents and Guest –Shawn Jordan, Rd Commissioner and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen’s Meeting minutes of March 16, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 12:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #12 as written: Appropriations: \$263,545.43 - Payroll: \$9,191.91 for a total of \$272,737.34, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the following purchase order requests for Snow & Ice: a request to pay Palmer Spring Co. \$60.60 for 2 u-bolts for truck11; a request to pay Sanel Auto \$96.00 for lockout-tag out kit; a request to pay Sanel Auto \$437.00 for hoses and fittings for truck 13; a request to pay O’Connor \$76.00 for rear main oil seal for truck 6; a request to pay O’Connor \$88.38 for screw, gaskets, spring nut, and RPM sensor for truck #6; and a request to pay Sanel Auto \$75.00 for 1/8” air fitting and \$158.00 for 5” elbow, u-joints and 303 fluid, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS Dept.:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the following purchase order requests for Fire/EMS Department: a request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$263.80 for snack food, coffee and computer b/u drive; a request to purchase 6”X 10’ LHF x RLM for \$466.00, a 6” 90° Hydrant kit for \$225.95 and a foam container wrench for \$11.95 from Heiman Fire Equipment; and a request to pay Hartford Communication \$85.00 for a mobile radio repair/reprogramming, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

- **Transfer Station Hours:** Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials are deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station. Stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclables, televisions or computer type products. A sticker is required for the

disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. A dumpster is available if you missed the curbside household trash pickup.

Selectman Black wanted to add Saturday when Representative Kenney and State Senator, Justin Chenette are here at the Municipal Building, she encourages people to come out and ask about the two bills-LD749 and LD751 which deals with Frye Island pulling out of the school district. If that happens the district would lose 1.5 million from the school budget.

Selectman Amatrudo gave an update on the 225 celebration. There are a number of events going on the first weekend of July, the 1st and 2nd. Saturday will officially kick off with the parade and ends Sunday with the fireworks. In between these events there is a lot going on; Francis Small Trust will be doing hikes; a car show following the parade across from the Mill Pond with DJ playing music and food vendors; at the ballfield there will be a family fun day with games, bounce house, and food; then on Saturday night there will be a variety show with a desert social at the school in the gym. They are looking for some people to bake cookies for the desert social and talent for the variety show. If you go to the 225 facebook page or web page you will find more information.

Shawn Jordan, Road Commissioner mentioned they have been out fixing potholes and will be measuring Doles Ridge Road to get the plan together for paving bids. Doles Ridge will be the first one paved.
