SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

March 30, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo and Debra Black
- Residents and Guest –Willard Boothby and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of March 30, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 13:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #13 as written: Appropriations: \$18,131.30 - Payroll: \$8,999.32 for a total of \$27,130.62, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve a request to pay Matheson Tri-Gas \$63.49 for argon and \$61.75 for oxygen and a request to pay Sanel Auto Parts \$24.85 for 7018-rod for truck 14, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Saco River TV:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the request to reimburse Fausto Blasco \$22.44 for two wall bracket, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS Dept.:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve the request to pay Sleepers Hardware \$51.11 for trim/cupboard paint for fire station, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Sanford Veteran Center's** Matthew Haley will hold an open house for veterans on April 21st and May 19th at the Old Town Hall from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Selectman Amatrudo mentioned this is an open house and any veteran that wants to stop in for any reason, please do so.
- **2017 Assessor's Notice:** The Assessors of the Town of Limington will be in their office on Monday, April 3, 2017 from 1:00-4:00 p.m. for the purpose of reviewing lists of the estates taxable in town. Selectman Braley mentioned if anyone has questions on their property to come in and review their property valuation.
- **MSAD# 6 Reapportionment Committee** met Tuesday; next meeting Monday, April 10th at 4 p.m. Selectman Braley reported this committee will need one more meeting to finish up and vote on the school board member size.

3. **Zoning Board of Appeals Member:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Douglas Hubbard for a 3 year term to the Zoning Board of Appeals, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
 4. **Health Officer:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Elaine Conant for a 3 year term as Health Officer, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
 5. **Emergency Management Director:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Stanley Hackett for a 1 year term as Emergency Management Director, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
 6. **Town's Public Access Officer:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Patricia M. Ramsdell for a 1 year term as Town's Public Access Officer, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
 7. **Animal Control Officer:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Kaden Flynn for 1 year term as the Animal Control Officer, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
 8. **Building Inspector, Code Enforcement Officer, Plumbing/Electrical Inspector:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Norman Hutchins for a 1 year term as Building Inspector, CEO, Plumbing/Electrical Inspector, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

- **Transfer Station Hours:** Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials are deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station. Stickers are not required for the disposal of recyclables, televisions or computer type products. A sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. A dumpster is available if you missed the curbside household trash pickup.
- **General Assistance Office:** GA office is open Tuesday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Applications are available at the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be completed with supporting documentation and signed. Selectman Amatrudo reported anyone looking for GA, there is a new application which can be picked up at front office.
