



# THE TOWN OF LIMINGTON

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## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

April 6, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo and Debra Black  
- Residents and Guest –Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of March 30, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 14:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #14 as written: Appropriations: \$24,222.96 - Payroll: \$11,713.25 for a total of \$35,936.21, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

### Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Braley read the following purchase order requests from Snow & Ice: a request to pay Cornish Hardware \$96.49 for a 5 gallon bucket of hydraulic fluid, grinding and cutting wheels and rope; a request to pay Hartford Communication \$72.50 for the loader antenna and labor; a request to pay Morton Salt \$2,180.00 for 33 tons of salt; a request to pay Williams Bros. \$448.49 for a Chelsea pump for truck 13; and a request to pay Sanel Auto Parts \$145.23 for parts for truck 10. Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve all Snow & Ice purchase orders as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Braley read the following purchase order requests from Fire/EMS Dept.: a request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$100.87 for twenty CPR-First Aid –AED Certified patches for non-EMT uniforms; a request to pay Standish Tire \$524.00 for balancing six tires and the purchase of two tires; a request to purchase April medical supplies for \$873.74; a request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$401.12 for updated videos -7 DVD's- for upcoming fire training class; and a request to pay Bound Tree Medical \$547.96 for four replacement kits for charge-pak battery chargers. Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve all Fire/EMS purchase orders as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

- **Assessors:** Selectman Amatrudo reported the Assessors are out valuating new construction and additions for 2016.
- **Executive Session:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion for Selectmen to hold an executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. § 405(6)(A) to discuss a personnel matter on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 4:00 p.m., so moved by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Appointment:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Donna Sawyer to a one year term as the Town's Saco River TV Committee Member, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Sanford Veteran Center's** Matthew Haley will hold an open house for veterans on April 21<sup>st</sup> and May 19<sup>th</sup> at the Old Town Hall from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Selectman Amatrudo urged and encouraged all Veterans to attend this open house.
