SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

April 20, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo and Debra Black
- Residents and Guest: Bonnie Lord, Willard Boothby, Paul Penna, Bill Brockman and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of April 13, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 16:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #16 as written: Appropriations: \$267,035.25 - Payroll: \$6,816.50 for a total of \$273,851.75, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Highway:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the highway purchase order requests: a request to pay Steep Falls Building Supply \$397.24 for posts, grade stakes, plywood, grass seed, hay, and marking paint; and a request to pay Portland Press Herald \$39.70 for invitation to bid on paving Doles Ridge Road, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Fire/EMS purchase order request to reimburse Earl Maxwell \$22.00 for PVC pipe for Forestry ATV, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the MMDY purchase order requests: a request to purchase metal leaf rake, axe, push and kitchen broom, tree loppers and a 10 gallon metal bucket for \$112.94 from Steep Falls Building Supply; a request to purchase plastic leaf rake, sledge hammer, metal utility rake, and 3 gallon metal bucket for \$50.96 from Sleepers Supermarket/Hardware; and a request to reimburse Howard Allen \$39.73 for deck mate screws for picnic tables, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

• **Meeting Open to Public:**

Willard Boothby asked about the Town Deputy coming in to report on what is going on. Selectman Black mentioned the Deputy was here two weeks ago and will be coming again when his schedule changes. Selectman Braley reported the Deputy came in on his day off.

MSAD 6 Superintendent, Paul Penna and Business Manager Bill Brockman gave a presentation on the school budget and answered questions. The Town of Limington is looking at a 2.99% increase in the school budget with an estimated increase cost of \$85,976. There are several bills in Augusta regarding Frye Island leaving the district: "An Act to Ensure Municipal Equity for the Town of Frye Island"; "An Act to Establish a Village Corporation"; and "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Process for a Single Municipality to Withdraw from a Regional School Unit". Any one of these pieces of legislation would hurt the Town financially.

Selectman Braley thanked both Mr. Penna and Mr. Brockman for the presentation and encouraged them to come in anytime with information.

• **Motion to Adjourn:**

Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to adjourn at 8:35 p.m., second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
