SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES May 4, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black
- Residents and Guest: Willard Boothby, Frank Carroll, Jr, a representative from Pike Industries, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Black so moved a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of April 27, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 18:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #18 as written: Appropriations: \$33,801.72 - Payroll: \$7,802.88 for a total of \$41,604.60, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests.

- **Highway:** Selectman Black so moved the requests to pay Steep Falls Building Supply \$397.24 for posts, grade stakes, plywood, grass seed, hay, and marking paint and to pay Portland Press Herald \$39.70 for invitation to bid on paving Doles Ridge Road, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Black so moved the request to reimburse Earl Maxwell \$22.00 for PVC pipe for Forestry ATV, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY:** Selectman Black so moved the request to pay Sleepers Supermarket/Hardware \$19.99 for a padlock to main gate, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Limington Youth League:** Selectman Black so moved the request to pay Xtreme Screen & Sportswear \$1,330.00 for 40 shirts and hats, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Saco River TV:** Selectman Black so moved the request to pay HR Distributors \$40.69 for phono plugs and audio cable and a request to reimburse Fausto Blasco \$20.96 for storage trays and supplies, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
