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SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

June 1, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo
- Residents and Guest: Willard Boothby, Bonnie Lord, Shawn Jordan, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of May 25, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote two in favor.
- **Approval of Warrant # 22:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #22 as written: Appropriations: \$24,399.72 - Payroll: \$7,319.00 for a total of \$31718.72, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

Selectmen Braley read the following purchase order requests.

- **FD/EMS Dept.:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Fire/EMS purchase order requests as follows:

A request to purchase medical supplies from Bound Tree Medical for \$467.88.

A request to pay Heiman Fire Equipment \$895.65 plus S/H for ARC-AFFF foam.

A request to pay Atlantic Partners EMS \$28.00 for CPR cards.

A request to reimburse Chief Hartford \$11.21 for paint brushes.

A request to pay Ed's Batteries \$72.00 for eight air-pack batteries.

A request to reimburse Chief Hartford \$72.42 for training breakfast and snacks.

A request to reimburse Chief Hartford \$89.35 for training breakfast and lunch.

Second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

- **Limington 225 Celebration:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve a request to rent 200 plastic chairs and one 8'X 16' stage for \$638.00 from Party Time Rentals, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

- **MMDY:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve a request to pay Sleepers Hardware \$39.73 for one gallon of paint for dock and tables, and a magnum lock and a request to reimburse Jason Truman \$33.03 for fuel and fuel can for lawn mower, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Vote on Lawn Mowing Bid:** Selectman Amatrudo reported two bidders had no insurance, one was too expensive, and one was submitted after the bid return date. Selectman Braley moved to deny all lawn mowing bids, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous. Selectmen will be re-soliciting bids for the lawn mowing.

- **Vote on Cleaning Bid:** Selectman Braley made a motion to award the Municipal Complex weekly cleaning for \$50.00 and Old Town Hall monthly cleaning for \$70.00 to Robert Scally of Hiram, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

- **Vote on Insurance Carrier for 2017-2018:** Selectman Braley made a motion to go with Maine Municipal Association for 2017-2018 Municipal insurance, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

- **Appointment:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to appoint Richard Staples to the Financial Advisory Committee for a term to run June 1, 2017- March 31, 2018 which fills Terri Anderson's term, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Willard Boothby wanted to know how townspeople are going to vote on the school budget this year. Selectman Braley mentioned for this year, the voting will be done the same (the budget voting procedure will be the same as prior years).

Shawn Jordan, Road Commissioner, mention they have been working on Douglas Road and that the log length firewood is being left beside the road if anyone is interested they may stop and grab it. He also reported he has been very busy and if there is an emergency to call the Town Office or the Sheriff's Department.
