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SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES June 15, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black.
- Residents and Guest: Bonnie Lord, Willard Boothby, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made motion to approve the Selectmen’s Meeting minutes of June 8, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 24:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #24: Appropriations: \$32,778.73 - Payroll: \$8,870.25 for a total of \$41,648.98, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

Selectmen Braley read the following purchase order requests:

- **FD/EMS Dept.:** A request to purchase two center pull paper towel rolls from Portland Paper for \$108.28; a request to purchase 2 boxes of 12 NFPA wildland gloves from Pequawket Lake Assn. for \$169.93; a request to pay Threads Rags & Duds \$205.00 for repair of two pairs of turnout gear pants; and a request to purchase two Michalin AS tires for \$470.00 from Standish Tire. Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the FD/EMS purchase order request, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY Capital Improvements:** a request to purchase lumber from Steep Falls Building Supply for a bench, a trimmer an fuel mix for trimmer for \$145.48 and a request to reimburse Howard Allen \$132.47 for deck-mate screws, bolts and screws. Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the FD/EMS purchase order request, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Highway Dept:** a request to purchase front wheel, swivel, axle assembly for the sweeper from Nortrax for \$879.00, motion to approve by Selectman Amatrudo, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Snow & Ice:** a request to pay Sleepers Hardware \$59.50 for cutting wheels, steel shackles and a chain money link, motion to approve by Selectman Amatrudo, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Limington Youth League:** a request to reimburse Denise Burnell \$214.63 for 32 trophies, motion to approve by Selectman Amatrudo, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY Operations:** a request to pay Sleepers Hardware \$27.74 for a gallon of paint for picnic tables, motion to approve by Selectman Amatrudo, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Selectmen did not award this bid at this time.

• **MSAD 6 School Budget Voting:** 135 Limington voters turned out to vote on the 48 million dollar school budget. Town vote was 71 yes and 63 no's.

• **Assessing** is almost completed. Selectman Black thanked Selectman Amatrudo and Braley for all the time and hard work they put into assessing this year.

• **York County:** The Public Hearing on the 2018 proposed budget for the County of York will be held on Wednesday, June 21, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in the Emergency Management Agency room of the York County Government Building (149 Jordan Springs Road in Alfred).
