## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

June 22, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen –Jeff Amatrudo and Debra Black.  
- Residents and Guest: Bonnie Lord, Willard Boothby, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Amatrudo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Former Selectmen** of 21 years Herbert Ramsdell passed away on Tuesday morning and funeral services will be held on Saturday at 11:00 am at the East Limington Baptist Church. Our condolences go out to the family.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of June 15, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 25:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #25: Appropriations: \$257,533.77 - Payroll: \$7,825.66 for a total of \$265,359.43, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
