SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

June 29, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen – Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black.
- Residents and Guest: Bonnie Lord, Willard Boothby, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of June 22, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 26:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #26: Appropriations: \$29,287.99 - Payroll: \$8,709.70 for a total of \$37,997.69, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

Selectmen Braley read the following purchase order requests:

- **Limington Youth League:** A request to reimburse Karen Twomey \$67.56 for soccer closing ceremonies and \$541.55 for concession supplies for 225 Celebration activities at the ballfield. Selectman Black made a motion to approve the Limington Youth League purchase order, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY Improvement Account:** A request to reimburse Howard Allen \$36.14 for stair fasteners and treated lumber. Selectman Black made a motion to approve the MMDY Improvements purchase order, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY Operations:** A request to pay Sleepers Supermarket/Hardware \$69.53 for screws, padlocks and keys. Selectman Black made a motion to approve the MMDY Operations purchase order, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **General Miscellaneous:** A request to reimburse Roxanne Herrick \$78.50 for mileage and tolls to attend Cash Management Class in Augusta. Selectman Black made a motion to approve the General Miscellaneous purchase order, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Mil Rate:** Selectmen Black made a motion to approve the property tax mil rate at .01180 for 2017, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **Transfer Station** will be closed Saturday and Sunday, July 1st and 2nd and reopen on Wednesday, July 5th, noon to 4 p.m.

Informational Bulletin:

- **Transfer Station hours:** Selectman Amatrudo reminded all the Transfer Station will be closed this weekend, July 1 and 2. Normal regular hours are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. Again, the Transfer Station will be closed July 1st and 2nd.
- **General Assistance Office** is open Tuesday from 3 to 5 p.m. Applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be completed with supporting documentation and signed. Selectman Amatrudo reported next week where the 4th of July is on Tuesday and the office is closed, General Assistance will be by appointment only.
- **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Tuesday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex. A Public Hearing will be held on July 4th at 7 p.m. to consider a Conditional Use Permit for a gravel pit at 16 Mildred Lane.
