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SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES July 13, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen – Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black.
- Residents and Guest: Bonnie Lord and Bruce Rozett.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of July 6, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 28:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #28: Appropriations: \$56,899.94 - Payroll: \$12,537.48 for a total of \$69,437.42, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

Selectmen Braley read the following purchase order requests:

- **Fire/EMS Department:** A request to pay North East Emergency Apparatus \$224.00 plus shipping for 2 batteries for thermal imager; a request to pay Bound Tree Medical \$842.56 for July medical supplies; and a request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$21.00 for Tide laundry pods and broom, Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the read purchase order requests, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Highway Dept.:** A request to pay Sleeper Hardware \$25.25 for clips, swivels, wire and bolts for repairs to truck, Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the request, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Present the results from the survey.** Selectman Amatrudo reported along with the 2017 annual Ambulance Subscription Form the Selectmen included a general questionnaire survey soliciting feedback, input, and suggestions from residents. The survey focused on three general areas: Are residents satisfied with the current services the Town provides; Are there areas residents feel need improvements; and do residents have suggestions they would like to share. Surveys were sent to the 1615 Limington households that received the Ambulance Subscription form and 251 households returned surveys resulting in a 16% response rate. Those 251 households self-reported a total of 522 residents resulting in a resident response rate of 14%. Out of the 251 surveys 69 or 28% provided contact information. Bruce Rozett spoke on how the survey information was compiled.
