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## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

July 20, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen – Emil Braley and Debra Black. (Jeff Amatrudo on vacation)  
- Residents and Guest: Willard Boothby, Jason Smith, Ben St. John, Bonnie Lord, Shawn Jordan, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.**
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve the Selectmen's Meeting minutes of July 13, 2017 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 29:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve Warrant #29: Appropriations: \$37,548.10 - Payroll: \$10,116.66 for a total of \$47,664.76, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

### Purchase Order Requests:

Selectmen Braley read the following purchase order requests:

- **Fire/EMS Department:** A request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$54.99 for Domano's pizza for daytime firefighter class, and a request to pay APEMS \$38.50 for CPR cards, motion to approve by Selectman Black, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY Reserve Account:** A request to pay Steep Falls Building Supply \$196.00 for foam float for day camp dock, motion to approve by Selectman Black, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Highway Dept.:** A request to purchase a solenoid, cable, switch, bolts and hardware from Sanel Auto Parts for truck 6, estimated cost \$125.00, motion to approve by Selectman Black, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Municipal Complex:** A request to have LaGasse Painting & Wallcovering paint the front and side entries of the Municipal Complex to include doors, entry columns, wooden façade, trim and ceilings for \$585.00 which includes all paint, motion to approve by Selectman Black, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

### Old and New Business:

- **FAC Appointment:** Selectman Braley made a motion to appoint Bruce Rozett as a Financial Advisory Committee member for a term to run July 20, 2017 thru March 31, 2019, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

### Informational Bulletin:

- **Transfer Station hours** are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush.
- **General Assistance Office** will be open by appointment only for the next three weeks and applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be completed with supporting documentation and signed.
- **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Tuesday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex. The Board needs one member and two alternates at this time, anyone interested please call the town office 207-637-2171.
- **Financial Advisory Committee** will meet August 8th at 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex. Jason Smith reported the committee will be in need of one or two Financial Advisory Committee members due to members moving out of town. Anyone interested contact the town office.

• **Meeting Open to Public:**

Willard Boothby spoke and feels the intent of having the Selectmen Meetings taped was to share more information and to let residents know what is going on. Selectman Braley reported Denise Burnell from the Limington Youth League was in and they had received a grant from the Narragansett Number One Foundation to do upgrades to the ballfields. They are getting quotes to have the work done and they have some equipment they would like to get rid-off. We talked about the process which has to been done to sell town property. Selectman Black mentioned Denise brought up that Standish has some playground equipment which they took from a school and the town will see if it is safe to be used at our ballfield.

Selectman Black mentioned the paving on Doles Ridge Road will be started by the end of this month probably and the culvert work on Axelsen and Boothby. There is a lot that we talk about. Selectman Braley mentioned the Selectmen are still discussing the Transfer Station and how to move forward with that, the concrete slab, the attendants building, etc.

Jason Smith wanted to know if a committee has been formed to do a Town logo. Selectman Braley mentioned he did not have a chance to speak with the other Selectmen about this committee. Jason mentioned there has been some talk about creating a fancier town seal-logo which could be used for everything in the town. The Youth League is talking about a new sign, the girls in the office have mentioned the sign out front is looking ratty and needing some work, and Jason has seen several of the “Welcome to Limington” signs sitting in the Selectmen’s office looking ratty. He feels if we start now getting a standardized sign for the town with the town seal it would bring continuity and maybe a sense of pride in the town.

Jason Smith mentioned the Youth League is considering contracting the mowing next year and he feels it might be cheaper to put all, town mowing on one contract. Selectmen will be working with the Youth League on this. Jason mentioned he would work with Selectmen, he thinks he has some contracts that deal with towns.

Shawn Jordan gave an update on the roadwork being done, Norton, Douglas, Tucker, River Road have been ditched and worked ditching and replacing two culverts on Coffin Hill Road today. F.R. Carroll hasn’t said anything about being late on paving Doles Ridge Road. He had been checking the property line for the Boothby Road culvert and waiting on Blair with the engineering work and all permits needed to put the job out to bid. Selectman Braley mentioned this culvert replacement would be done with Block Grant reserve funds and Shawn feels that there still might be State grant money for reimbursements on expenditures.

Selectman Black mentioned if everyone would do their part on recycling we would save a lot of money. Selectman Braley stated he wished anyone with ideas to help in recycling that they would share them. Ben St. John mentioned he used to recycle when he could do it on his time but with the compactor at the Transfer Station he has to do it on town time. Bonnie Lord mentioned pay per bag seems to be working well in some towns. Fausto Blasco spoke on recycling and updating the Waste Disposal tab on the towns’ website.

Selectman Black made a motion to adjourn at 7:57 p.m., second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
