



# THE TOWN OF LIMINGTON

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## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES September 7, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen – Emil Braley-Chairman, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black – Residents and Guest: Deputy Trainque, Kathy Amatrudo, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.** The meeting was not taped- the video equipment operator did not show up.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the Selectmen Meeting Minutes of August 30, 2017, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 36:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #36: Appropriations: \$307,555.05 - Payroll: \$10,517.75 for a total of \$318,072.80, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

### Purchase Order Requests:

Selectman Amatrudo read the purchase order requests as follows:

#### • **Fire/EMS Dept.:**

1. A request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$428.00 for department t-shirts.
2. A request to purchase a Junkin Basket Stretcher from Heiman Fire Equipment for \$625.00.
3. A request to purchase part for broken hose cutter from K & T Environmental Equipment for \$179.69. Selectman Black so moved the above requests, second by Selectman Braley and the vote unanimous.

#### • **Highway Dept.:**

1. A request to pay Metcalf's \$193.00 for hay and grass seed. A request to pay Sleeper's Hardware \$7.85 for a belt. Selectman Black so moved the request, second by Selectman Braley and the vote unanimous.

#### • **Limington Youth League:**

1. A request to pay Xtreme Screen & Sportswear \$1,822.00 for 63 soccer jerseys. A request to reimburse Karen Twomey \$331.09 for soccer balls, socks, and goal posts. Selectman Black so moved the request, second by Selectman Braley and the vote unanimous.

### Old and New Business:

#### • **Weekly Update on Selectmen activities:**

Selectman Black mentioned she will be meeting with a representative from the American Red Cross tomorrow who would like to hold a blood drive here tentatively November 27<sup>th</sup>.

Selectman Amatrudo introduced Deputy Eric Trainque who is replacing Deputy Searway. Deputy Trainque gave a brief introduction, spoke on what he has been working on and solved, and what he would like to do for the town. He would like to improve interaction with the residents of our rural town and will hold office hours at the Municipal Building on Tuesdays' from ten to noon. Anyone is welcome to come and speak with Deputy Trainque on issues or just come to chat, the door is open.

Deputy Trainque gave a reminder that school is back in session, please drive slow and watch for children.

• **Public Hearing** to be held September 21<sup>st</sup> on the Town of Limington's General Assistance Ordinance and the new October 1, 2017-September 30, 2018 "General Assistance Ordinance Appendix" (A-D) which are the GA maximums allowable on housing, food, utilities, heating, personal care & household supplies and the overall maximums on income allowable.

• **Appointment:** Selectman Black made a motion to appoint Kathleen Amatrudo as Director of the Limington Seniors Program for a term to run August 7, 2017 to March 31, 2018, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

**Informational Bulletin:**

- **Transfer Station hours** are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of metals, demolition, or brush. Selectman Amatrudo reported the concrete pad is completed at the Transfer Station and the household trash dumpsters will be moved over to that area.
- **General Assistance Office** is open Tuesday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be completed with supporting documentation and signed.
- **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Tuesday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex, next meeting September 18th. Starting in October the Planning Board meetings will move to the first and third Monday evenings at 7:00 p.m.
- **Financial Advisory Meetings** are held on the second Tuesday of the month. The next meeting will be September 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. here in the Municipal meeting room.
- **Five Loaves Community Kitchen** located at Steep Falls County Church, 35 Main St. Rte. 11, Steep Falls offers a free meal every Wednesday from 4:40 – 6:00 pm. All are welcomed. Food boxes of meat, produce, bread and pastries also available, no forms to fill out, no qualifications to meet. The Five Loaves Community Kitchen is a Good Shepherd Food Bank agency.
