## SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES October 12, 2017

- **Attendance:** Selectmen – Emil Braley-Chairman, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black.  
Residents and Guests: Jason Smith, Willard Boothby, David Lawnsby, and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.** with the salute to the American Flag.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the October 5, 2017 Selectmen Minutes, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 41:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #41 as posted: Appropriations: \$39,554.86 - Payroll: \$7,219.50 for a total of \$46,774.36, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

### Purchase Order Requests:

Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests.

- **Parade Donation Acct:** A request to pay the Town of Limington \$125.00 for one week of summer camp which was a July 4<sup>th</sup> prize for the bicycle decoration entries, Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the request, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS Dept.:** A request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$163.00 for station coffee and snacks, motion to approve by Selectman Braley, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Limington Youth League:** A request to pay Lake Region Pest Control \$190.00 for ballfield treatment for ticks and mosquitoes, motion to approve by Selectman Black, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

### Old and New Business:

#### • **Weekly Update on Selectmen activities:**

Selectman Black reported that forms for the H.B. Emery School Free Lunch Program are available at the Town Clerks Office.

Selectman Black mentioned the Selectmen met with the Financial Advisory Committee on Tuesday night and managers come in to present their budgets. Selectmen Braley reported this started the budget process for next year and listed those who were in attendance; Planning Board, Parade Committee, Snowmobile Club, CEO's budget, Davis Memorial Library, Limington Youth League and the budget for the Appeals Board and Finance Committee.

Selectman Black reported she met with Committee Chairman, Diane Hubbard at the Old Town Hall and they went down cellar to see the condition of the area from the moisture and went upstairs to see where there is some rot in the floor where the roof had leaked before it was replaced. They will be working on trying to get some things fixed, get some quotes, and do some maintenance on the building.

Selectman Braley mentioned Peter Malia came in on Tuesday and spoke a little more on the Ice Fishing Derby. Also, he deals with cameras and different types of security, and had some proposals on things that the Town could do in the future at the Transfer Station if we wanted to look into it.

A few employees also came in to talk with Selectmen this week.

- **Transfer Station** –Transfer Station will no longer accept brush and yard waste.
- **Speeding:** Selectman Black advised where Dole's Ridge and the Sokokis Ave paving is almost completed people should respect the speed limit and slow down for the Deputy Sheriff is out there.
- **Town Deputy:** Selectman Braley reminded all that Deputy Trainque is in his office here at the Town Hall on Tuesday's from 10am-12pm and is planning to attend the Selectmen's Meeting next Thursday as well.

Selectman Braley also reported he had a call into the Sheriff to request a time when he would be able to come in and meet with Selectmen to give an update on things going on and the contract.

**Informational Bulletin:**

- **Transfer Station hours** are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of everything except recycling and household trash.
- **General Assistance Office** is open Tuesday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be completed with supporting documentation and signed.
- **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Monday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex.
- **Financial Advisory Meetings** are held on the second Tuesday of the month. The next meeting will be October 10th at 7:00 p.m. here at Town Hall.
- **Five Loaves Community Kitchen** located at Steep Falls County Church, offers a free meal every Wednesday from 4:40 – 6:00 pm. All are welcomed. Food boxes of meat, produce, bread and pastries also available, no forms to fill out, no qualifications to meet. The Five Loaves Community Kitchen is a Good Shepherd Food Bank agency.
- **2017 AppleCycle Charity Bike Ride**, a fundraising bike ride that benefits a youth nonprofit –the Community Bicycle Center, which provides free programming to over 400 kids each year during the critical after-school hours and summer months. They will be rolling through Limington on Saturday, October 14, 2017. The route includes Doles Ridge Road and Cape Road so please drive safely and watch out for the cyclist.
- **Committee Openings:** The Town has openings on the following committees: Old Town Hall Preservation Committee, the Planning Board, the Financial Advisory Board and MMDY Oversight Committee . Willard Boothby asked about the Frye Island deal and if we have to go through that every year. Selectman Black mentioned she watched the School Board Meeting last week and one of the Board members mentioned that Frye Island has their Town Meeting in October and she thinks he said they wanted to raise money for Frye Island to fight this again. She suggested Mr. Boothby go onto the Frye Island website and look at the minutes of the meeting.

Jason Smith asked if the Sheriff will be coming in to speak with the Finance Committee. Selectman Braley mentioned he usually comes to the January, Saturday meeting with the Chief Deputy and the contract deputy and does a presentation. Jason mentioned he had asked Roxanne to have the Road Commissioner and Fire Department present their budgets on different nights. The Fire Department will present their budget in November and the Road Commissioner will present his budget in December if Selectmen were alright with that. Selectmen saw no problem with that.

Selectman Black made a motion to adjourn at 7:18 p.m., second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
