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SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES December 14, 2017

- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.**
- **Attending:** Selectmen-Emil Braley, Jeff Amatrudo, and Debra Black; Resident: Deputy Eric Trainque and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve the December 7, 2017 Selectmen Minutes as written, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.
- **Approval of Warrant # 50:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #50 as published: Appropriations: \$44,947.50 - Payroll: \$8,633.13 for a total of \$53,580.63, second by Selectman Black and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve the following purchase order request: a request to pay Sanel Auto Parts \$250.00 for filters and fluids to service the loader; a request to pay Morton Salt \$1,940.48 for 32 tons of salt; a request to pay S.A. McLean estimated \$1,000.00 for front wing tower, \$200.00 for lower wing arm, \$90.00 for two spinner bearings, and \$1,100.00 for truck 8 parts- take-up bearings, sander chain links, carbide and cutting edges and pillow block bearings; second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Block Grant:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve a request to pay F.R. Carroll \$200.00 for cold patch, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Maintenance Building:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve a request to pay Steep Falls Building Supply \$350.00 for material to do building repairs, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Capital Improvement-Brine System:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve a request to pay Cornish Hardware estimated \$100.00 for bolts, nuts, washers, hose, and clamps for brine system, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **Fire/EMS Dept.:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve the following purchase order request: a request to purchase batteries from Ed's Batteries for \$222.55; a request to purchase 6 pairs of structural fire gloves from Heiman for \$353.70; and a request to purchase 2 Lakeland Ansi parkas from Bergeron Protective Clothing for \$400.00, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.
- **MMDY Capital Improvements:** Selectman Black made a motion to approve a request to purchase 6.5 feet of hand railing and brackets from Lowe's for stairs at the beach for \$157.24, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Selectman Braley mentioned Selectmen worked on the 2018 budget this week.

- **Deputy Trainque:** Town Deputy Eric Trainque reported he is back from his military obligation and is working on some drug cases in town. Deputy Trainque asked that people monitor their speed where the winter season is here and remember to breakdown boxes of high ticket items purchased this Holiday Season before putting them out beside the road.
