- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:07 p.m.**
- **Attending:** Selectmen-Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo (Debra Black not in) Resident and Guest: Wanda Whitten and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve January 11, 2018 Selectmen Minutes as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Weekly Update on Selectmen activities:** Selectman Braley mentioned the Selectmen worked on the budget for 2018 and trying to get all paperwork in line. He also mentioned the Transfer Station Attendants shed arrived Wednesday and Selectmen are in the process of having the electrical done.
- **Household Waste Dumpsters:** Selectman Braley reported that one of the household waste dumpsters from the Transfer Station and the one in the Municipal parking lot will be removed February 1st.

- **The Annual Budget Meeting** will be held Saturday, January 20th beginning at 9:00 a.m., anyone is welcome to attend.
- **Limington Youth League** will host a Winter Carnival, Saturday, February 17th from 10 a.m. -8 p.m. and Sunday, February 18th from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
- **Annual Fishing Derby** will be held on January 27th at Horne Pond, Limington. Registration will be at the Limington boat launch Friday, January 26th from 4-9 p.m. Proceeds benefit Veteran's Adaptive Sports & Training program & the Standish Fish & Game Club.
- **Benefit Dinner and Dance:** The Eastman family of Limington lost their home to a fire. Everyone was safe, but the house and all of their belongings have been destroyed. Bella Vista Event Center in the Old Limerick Mill, 171 Washington Street, Limerick, will be hosting a fundraiser for this family on Saturday, January 20, 2018.
