SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES JANUARY 25, 2018

- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.**
- **Attending:** Selectmen-Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo (Debra Black not in) Resident and Guest: Wanda Whitten and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve January 18, 2018 Selectmen Minutes as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

- **Warrant # 4, January 25th approval:**

Appropriations:	\$ 20,629.28
Payroll:	\$ 8,304.16
Total Warrant:	\$ 28,933.44

Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #4 as posted, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the following purchase order request for Fire/EMS: a request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$352.00 for purchase of 2018 MEMS protocol books for EMT's and Rescue trucks and \$187.66 for "Golden Rule Guide Books" for new officers; a request to purchase two wire harnesses for heart monitors on Rescue 1 & 2 from Bound Tree Medical for \$1,159.98; a request to have Annual Flow Tests on all air-packs plus parts from North East Emergency Apparatus, not to exceed \$1,000.00; a request to purchase 2- G-3 perfusion EMS packs, 2- G-3 IV cell modules and 2- G3 responder EMS packs from Bound Tree Medical for \$1,150.94; a request to have Coastal T-Shirts letter the back of two new EMS coats; and a request to reimburse Michael Hartford \$53.96 for two organizer boxes for new drug box and two ratchet straps for ATV trailer, second by Selectman Amatrudo, vote unanimous.
- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the following purchase order request for Snow & Ice: a request to pay Napa-Buxton \$392.81 for mini torch, relay starter, hydraulic hose, fittings and monitors; a request to pay Napa-Kezar Falls \$162.79 for tools, lamp fender & harness; a request to pay Sanel Auto Parts \$498.11 for parts to plow trucks and \$45.30 for engine oil and filters; a request to pay S.A. McLean \$4,628.00 for cutting edges and carbides, nuts and bolts for plow trucks; and a request to pay Eastman Welding \$75.00 for 9' of 2 X 3/4 steel, second by Selectman Amatrudo, vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Weekly Update on Selectmen activities:** Selectman Amatrudo reported most of the Selectmen's time was taken up with the budget this week.
- **2018 March Town Meeting Warrant Articles:** Selectman Amatrudo mad a motion to approve Friday, March 2, 2018 Town Meeting Secret Ballot questions 2-4 and Saturday, March 3, 2018 Town Meeting Warrant Articles 5-30, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

- **Limington Youth League** will host a Winter Carnival, Saturday, February 17th from 10 a.m. -8 p.m. and Sunday, February 18th from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
- **Annual Fishing Derby** will be held on January 27th at Horne Pond, Limington. Registration will be at the Limington boat launch Friday, January 26th from 4-9 p.m. Proceeds benefit Veteran's Adaptive Sports & Training program & the Standish Fish & Game Club.

- **2018 Dog Registrations** are due. The fee is \$6.00 for neutered dogs and \$11.00 for non-neutered dogs. A late fee of \$25.00 will be imposed after January 31.
 - **Transfer Station hours** are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of everything except recycling and household trash.
 - **General Assistance Office** will be by appointment only next week. Applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be accompanied with supporting documentation and signed.
 - **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Monday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex.
 - **Financial Advisory Meetings** are held on the second Tuesday of the month.
 - **Five Loaves Community Kitchen** located at the Steep Falls County Church, offers a free meal every Wednesday from 4:40 – 6:00 p.m. all are welcome.
