SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES February 15, 2018

- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen’s Meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.**
- **Attending:** Selectmen-Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo - Resident and Guest: Bonnie Lord, Jason Smith and Roxanne Herrick.
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve February 8, 2018 Selectmen Minutes as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

• **Warrant # 7 approval:**

Appropriations:	\$ 20,998.72
Payroll:	\$ 8,898.00
Total Warrant:	\$ 29,896.72

Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve Warrant #7 as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests for Snow & Ice:
 1. A request to purchase tow slings, shackles, and safety hooks from Hydraulic Hose & Assembly for \$137.59. 2.
 2. A request to purchase six trip-springs for truck #15 from Allied Equipment for \$564.74. 3.
 3. A request to purchase 200 yards of winter sand from F.R. Carroll for \$1350.00.
 4. A request to pay Morton Salt \$4,033.53 for 66.56 tons of road salt.
 5. A request to purchase one inverter and four-isolator mounts from Nortrax for loader.
 6. A request to purchase a hub assembly for truck #11 from Freightliner of Maine for \$268.00.
 7. A request to purchase a thermostat and drag line for truck #13 & 9 from Portland North for estimated \$218.78.
 8. A request to purchase two recap tires and two steel wheels for truck #11 from Wing Foot Commercial Tire for \$630.00.

Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the purchase orders as read, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

• **Limington Youth League Donation Account:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the request to reimburse Karen Twomey \$34.00 for Winter Carnival supplies, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

• **Limington Youth League:** Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order request for Limington Youth League:

1. A request to purchase and reimburse Karen Twomey \$200 for a PA system for the Youth League.
2. A request to rent a portable unit for the Winter Carnival from Blow Bros. for \$60.00.
3. A request to pay Your Weekly Shopping Guide \$90.00 for the Winter Carnival ad.
4. A request to purchase one “Umbrella Movie License” unlimited from Motion Picture Licensing Corp for \$590.00.

Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the purchase order requests as read, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

• **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve the request to reimburse Chris Small \$68.55 for lamination sheets and one ready index, and to pay Kezar Falls Napa \$185.00 for Squad 5 parts, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Weekly Update on Selectmen activities:** Selectman Braley reported on Monday Selectmen held an interview with a videographer who applied for the Video Coordinator position and reviewed and signed payroll sheets. Tuesday night Selectman Braley attended the Financial Advisory meeting and Selectman Amatrudo mentioned on Wednesday they went over some property tax issues.
- **Appoint a Fire/EMS Quality Assurance (QA/QI) Officer** for six months, retro January 1, 2018 to June 1, 2018. Selectman Braley made a motion to appoint Daniel Thompson as Fire/EMS QA/QI Officer. Andrea Thompson as EMS Assistant Chief, and Chris Small as Fire Department Assistant Chief, all for a term to run January 1, 2018 to June 30, 2018, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
- **Limington Selectmen will hold a Public Hearing**, Thursday, February 22, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Complex meeting room to hear comments regarding the Deputy Sheriff Contract secret ballot question for March 2nd Town Meeting and the extension of the Moratorium Ordinance Regarding Recreational Marijuana Retail Establishments and Social Clubs.

- **Town offices will be closed** Monday, February 19th for President's Day.
- **Limington Youth League** will host a Winter Carnival, Saturday, February 17th from 10 a.m. -8 p.m. and Sunday, February 18th from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
- **Transfer Station hours** are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of everything except recycling and household trash.
- **General Assistance Office** will be by appointment only next week. Applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be accompanied with supporting documentation and signed.
- **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Monday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex.
- **Financial Advisory Meetings** are held on the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. here, next meeting March 13th.
- **Five Loaves Community Kitchen** located at the Steep Falls County Church, offers a free meal every Wednesday from 4:40 – 6:00 p.m. all are welcome. They are also an approved food pantry.
- **Food Pantry:** The Limington Orthodox Presbyterian Church offers a food pantry for Limington residents only who need help putting food on the table. - **Selectman Braley** spoke on the winter sand for public use and that its intent was for small quantities (two-5 gallon buckets) not a truck load. People are taking so much the Road Commissioner is getting calls at home in the middle of the night, that there is no sand. Please be courteous and think of others who might need sand.

Selectman Braley also mentioned that the Fire Department gave Earl Maxwell, volunteer firefighter, a retirement party. He has 30 years plus working for the department and members made Earl a lifetime member of the Limington Fire Department. Selectman Braley publicly thanked Earl for all the time he gave to the Town of Limington.

- **Meeting Open to Public:**

Jason Smith spoke on the LYL Winter Carnival this weekend. The ice skating rink is coming along good and should be ready for this weekend. Sunday evening, February 18th will be movie night starting 6:00p.m. at the Old Town Hall. There was discussion on the changing of a purchase order after Selectmen had signed it.
