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SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES March 1, 2018

- **Selectman Braley called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.**
- **Attending:** Selectmen-Emil Braley and Jeff Amatrudo – Residents: Wanda Whitten and Roxanne Herrick
- **Selectmen Minutes:** Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve February 22, 2018 Selectmen Minutes as written, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

•Warrant # 9 approval:

Appropriations: \$ 34,751.68
Payroll: \$ 7,329.75
Total Warrant: \$ 42,081.43

Selectman Amatrudo made a motion to approve as posted Warrant #9, second by Selectman Braley and vote unanimous.

Purchase Order Requests:

- **Snow & Ice:** Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests for Snow & Ice, motion to accept as read by Selectman Braley, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
 1. A request to pay Sanel Auto \$325.40 for plow truck parts.
 2. A request to pay Palmer Spring \$638.00 for front springs on truck #13.
 3. A request to pay Kezar Falls Napa \$106.22 for plow truck parts.
- **Fire/EMS:** Selectman Amatrudo read the following purchase order requests for Fire/EMS, motion to approve by Selectman Braley, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.
 1. A request to pay Kezar Falls Napa \$133.13 for Squad 5 strobe lamp.
 2. A request to pay Sleepers Supermarket \$46.20 for structural fire crew lunch.
 3. A request to reimburse Chief Hartford \$23.73 for department refreshments.
- **Maintenance Bldg.:** Selectman Braley made a motion to approve a request to pay Sleepers Hardware \$39.85 for airline piping, second by Selectman Amatrudo and vote unanimous.

Old and New Business:

- **Weekly Update on Selectmen activities:** Selectman Braley mentioned the Selectmen have been busy this week getting ready for Town Meeting, checking the budget, etc. Also, Selectman Braley and Road Commissioner Shawn Jordan went to Augusta last Friday to pick-up a speed sign that reads speed and collects other data which can be used on the Roads Program. This sign was through a grant and no cost to the Town.

- **Notice of Tax Acquired Property Sale:**

The Town of Limington has tax title to one parcel of real estate to be sold by sealed bid:

A minimum bid is \$10,000.00.

- **Annual Town Meeting:** Friday, March 2nd polls open at 8 a.m. for secret ballot question voting and close at 8 p.m. Polls will reopen at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, March 3rd for voting on the Annual Town Meeting warrant articles.
- **LIHEAP:** Selectman Amatrudo reported the Selectmen received a letter from York County Community Action which stated: “We know there are homeowners and renters in York County who need and are eligible for heating assistance through LIHEAP-the Low Home Energy Assistance Program- but have not applied. LIHEAP can save lives and the application process takes only a phone call to begin. There is no need for an applicant to leave home to get the application underway. All the applicant needs to do is call our LIHEAP office at 324-5762 or 1-800-965-5762.” Selectman Amatrudo mentioned the LIHEAP information is posted on the lobby bulletin board and flyers will be given to the Town Deputy to hand out and available at the Town Office.

Informational Bulletin:

- **Transfer Station hours** are Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday 12-4 p.m. Recyclable materials go in the compactor at the Transfer Station. A town sticker is required for the disposal of everything except recycling and household trash.
 - **General Assistance Office** is open Tuesday’s from 3-5 p.m. Applications are available from the Town Clerks office during their normal business hours and must be accompanied with supporting documentation and signed.
 - **Planning Board Meetings** are held on the first and third Monday evenings, 7:00 p.m. here at the Municipal Complex.
 - **Financial Advisory Meetings** are held on the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. here.
 - **Five Loaves Community Kitchen** located at the Steep Falls County Church, offers a free meal every Wednesday from 4:40 – 6:00 p.m. all are welcome. They are also an approved food pantry.
 - **Food Pantry:** The Limington Orthodox Presbyterian Church offers a food pantry for Limington residents only who need help putting food on the table. This is open once a month, and is by appointment only. If you need assistance, you can call the church at 637-2061, leave a message and they’ll get back to you.
 - **Committee Openings:** The Town has openings on the following committees: Old Town Hall Preservation Committee, the Planning Board, Moy Mo Da Yo Recreational Oversight Committee and the Financial Advisory Board.
