Shoreland Height Changes

- 8.H.1.(d) The maximum height of the principal structure may not be made greater than $\frac{15}{25}$ feet or the height of the existing structure, whichever is greater.
- 8.H.1.e.(i) For structures located less that 75 feet from the normal high-water line of a water body, tributary stream, or upland edge of a wetland, the maximum combined total footprint for all structures may not be expanded to a size greater than 1,000 square feet or 30% larger than the footprint that existed on January 1, 1989, whichever is greater, the maximum height of any structure may not be greater than 20 35 feet or the height of the existing structure, whichever is greater.
- 8.H.1.e.(ii) The maximum height of any structure may not be made greater than $\frac{25}{25}$ feet or the height of the existing structure, whichever is greater.
- 8.H.1.e.(iii) The maximum height of any structure many not be made greater than 25 35 feet or the height of the existing structure, which is greater, except that any portion of those structure located ess than 75 feet from the normal high-water line of a water body, tributary stream, or upland edge of a wetland must meet the footprint and height limits in Section 8.H.1.b (i) and Section 8.H.1.c(i), above.
