Letter for donations -

Grace and Lauriejane worked to create a letter to be sent to individual donors, people who are interested in giving to the OTH Foundation Fund. We will get the letter to the Select Board members this week for approval. At our meeting we tinkered with the date and a few things. Overall, a nicely written letter.

Fund raising –

Raffle 1 - WOOD (2 separate cords) -a thank you needs to be written to Skip Murray. Raffle 2- AFGHAN - a thank you has been written to Bobbi Braley. Lauriejane made a motion that we accept the new cost of the tickets. \$49 + \$63.89= \$113.40 We chose to go with \$5.00 amount for our raffle tickets for all tickets. Puts a value on our items and makes it easy to make change. The tickets were twice what we expected them to be, yet they have our logo, all information, nicely done. We have to understand that price, materials, and labor have gone up.

This year, the OTHPC decided to have a booth at the Limington Fireworks to sell our raffle tickets.

Fireworks how many tickets sold? \$28 wood, \$10 afghan = \$190 + \$35 in donations = \$225 in total and well worth our time.

Modern Pest report (Laurie)

Laurie met with the worker from Modern Pest. They toured and inspected all 3 floors of the OTH building. Only evidence was sawdust with body parts, which indicates carpenter ants. This company is not a one time deal, it begins a yearly contract. The contract can be thousands of dollars. We are clear that we have no powder post beetles which as our concern, and there is no current activity. We recommend that we not go with this service at this time. We might consider one time treatment of the sills. Laurie will ask the Modern Pest Co. - Do we owe you anything for a quote?
